

# Certified Nurse Assistant

## Allied Health

*Must be 18 years of age to enroll*

This course meets the classroom and clinical requirements for Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services to be a Certified Nurse Assistant and is appropriate for those new to the healthcare field. **Starting wages are typically \$11.00-12.50 per hour.**

Required final State Exam fee is included. State testing dates will be scheduled post-class, announced by instructor. Clinical hours will always be 6:45am-5:15pm.

### Requirements

- Must be 18 years of age and employable in a long-term care facility.
- Must attend mandatory orientation.
- During orientation, students will receive the Health Report form to have completed by a healthcare professional and turned in to the office by the second week of class.
- Proof of Flu vaccine is required if taking class in spring or fall. A negative TB skin test must be performed within the previous six months.

No refund for any reason after registration, unless class is canceled by the college. Classes are not eligible for Federal Student Loans, Pell or FAFSA.

Course may be eligible for SkillUP or America's Promise Grant funding based on individual eligibility factors.
