

IV Therapy Certification

Allied Health Course WDH-455

Must be 18 years of age to enroll

The IV Therapy Certification course prepares the non-IV Certified qualified practical nurse to safely perform the functions and procedures outlined by the State of Missouri Board of Nursing. Upon successful completion of the program, clinical experience, and final exam, the LPN is classified as an IV Certified LPN by the State of Missouri Board of Nursing.

Requirements

To register, students must complete the following:

- Registration paperwork.
- Successfully pass a criminal background check.
- Present a valid driver's license or federal ID.
- Present a copy of their HS diploma or equivalent.
- Present a copy of their LPN License

Before clinical component, students must:

- Successfully pass a random urine drug screen.
- Be passing the class with an 80% or higher.
- Submit a copy of their state license.
- Complete all other required clinical paperwork.
- All payments made and account in good standing.

Class Cost
