



Certified Logistics Technician (CLT)

The Certified Logistics Technician (CLT) program will help you earn a nationally portable certification in the **Supply Chain Logistics** industry.

You will learn the in-demand skills needed for a long-term career in over 5.8 million supply chain logistics jobs.

This course follows the Manufacturing Skill Standards Council (MSSC) curriculum guidelines which focus on the core skills and knowledge needed by the nation's front-line production and material handling workers.

You'll also receive hands-on instruction for basic Fork-Truck skills including understanding the machine, hazards, safety, pre-operation inspections, gravity triangle and more.



Earning this credential will prepare you for jobs in fulfillment centers, warehouses, distribution centers and manufacturing facilities.

This 12-week course will meet evenings, once weekly, for three hours. Participants should be prepared to commit up to 10-12 hours per week doing online coursework outside of class time.
